

Inviting Visiting Scholars Protocol

- 1. Potential scholar makes themselves known to a potential mentor on campus.
- 2. Mentor determines the appropriateness of the scholar's work to their own.
- 3. Mentor secures approval from their dean and an invitation letter is issued.
 - a. Must include
 - i. Dean's signature
 - ii. Dates of visit
 - iii. Sponsoring department
 - iv. Research project and academic expectations
 - v. Funding source
- 4. Material collected for the issuance of DS-2019.
 - a. Biographical page from passport
 - b. Proof of funding (\$2,000 per month)
 - c. Proof of English proficiency
 - d. CV
 - e. Research plan
- 5. DS-2019 issued and mailed to potential scholar.
- 6. Potential scholar meets with embassy official and J1 visa is approved or denied.
- 7. Scholar arrives in US and checks in with the ISSS to be registered in SEVIS.
- 8. Scholar meets with mentor and enacts research plan.
 - a. Publishable manuscript
 - i. Process determined by mentor and scholar
 - b. Audit (sit in) on class
 - Classes are chosen in conjunction with mentor and in consultation with Dean and mentor introduces scholars to professor.
