ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete application consists of two parts: an online graduate admission application and submission of all required materials (supplemental materials, transcripts, and payment). Please note that application requirements are unique to individual programs. Please carefully review the requirements and check the application deadline for your individual program.

Admission is granted jointly by the Graduate School and the academic department in which the student plans to pursue his or her studies. Admission to graduate study is contingent on:

- an approved baccalaureate degree granted by an institution that is accredited by an approved regional accrediting agency or its equivalent (for international applicants);
- a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) in the baccalaureate degree.

In accordance with federal regulations for financial aid eligibility, all students (except Buffalo State graduates) are required to submit an official final transcript, which includes the degree earned, to the Graduate School by the start of their graduate work.

Entry into a graduate educator preparation program requires a bachelor's degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and the submission of a score from the GRE, the MAT, or a nationally normed graduate-level assessment as recommended by the intended program of study. Individual departments may establish higher standards for admission or require scores from national tests such as the GRE or MAT or other materials.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Graduate students can receive funding for their education and for research and travel opportunities in various ways. Assistantships pay stipends for student work and offer tuition support. Fellowships offer scholarship money and tuition support. Students may also request support for research and travel.

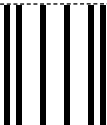

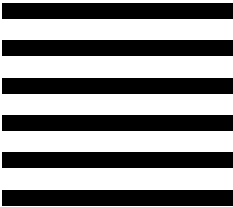
