- **TOEFL/ IELTS Waiver**

- **6 levels of study (beginning to advanced)**

New Students take the TOEFL placement exam on the first day of the session and are placed in the appropriate level for each core class (Reading & Culture, Listening & Speaking, Grammar & Writing).

- **A minimum of 20 hours of class per week**

Full-time students study a minimum of 20 hours per week in core classes. More can be added through the Bridge Program.

- **Professional, experienced teachers**

All IELI faculty members have master's degrees in TESL (Teaching English as a Second Language). Many have also lived and taught outside of the United States.
